her Decese to be Equilly divided Between y three youngest Child
Samuel James & Nancey-----
Secondly I give & bequeath to my Beloved Son John Dabbs one
Negro Boy named Will to him his heirs & assigns forever-----
Thirdley also I lend to My Beloved Wife with the Plantation
one Negro girl named lucey dureing During herlife and after
her Deces'd to be also Dividied she and her Increase Equilly
the abou Named three youngest Children to them & there heirs
forever Fourthly I give & Bequeath to my Beloved Son Josiah
Dabbs one hundred Dollers in Bonds on Notes that is Due to my
Estate or Shall be Due to him his heirs assigns forever-----
Fithly I give and bequeath to my beloved Son William Dabbs
One Negro Boy named Frank to him his heirs and assigns for -
ever Sixthly I give and Bequeath to my Belove Son Nathanil
Dabbs One Negro Woman named Phillis to him his heirs & assigns
forever Seventhly I give and Bequeath to my Beloved son Rich-
ard Dabbs one Hundred Dollers In Notes on Bond Due or Shall
be Due to my Estate with two Cows & Calfs to him his heirs
assigns forever

and one Colt that that has But one Eye to Samuel the Said land

to be Equilly-Deveded according to quantity and Quattity to

them there heirs and & Assigns forever-----

one Negro girl Named Ann to her her heirs One Bed and Furniture

one Bay Filly & Good womans sackett the above mentiend to her
