and Dispose of the Same in the following manner and form - - -
Imprimis it is my Will and I do order all my Just Debts to be
paid and my funeral Expence - - - - -
Item I Give and Bequeath to my Dearly Beloved Wife Elizabeth
Good a Horse and Saddle and her Bed and furniture to be at her
own Disposal, as for my Land and all and singular my good^s an
Chattles I Order them to Stand as they are for the Suport of
my family until the youngest child comes of Age, and then to be
Valued or Sold and my Wife to have one third During Life or a
Child^s part if She Maries. if She remains a widow there will
be but two third^s of the Estate to Divide amongst the Children
if not it is to be Equealy Divided, and I Do Appoint Elizabeth
Good my Beloved wife and John Bankhead and John Mitchell to be
my Executors of this my Last Will and testament and I Do hereby
Disanul and Revoke and Disallow all and Every other will and
testament or legacies and Executors by me in any wise before
this time Named Rectifying and Confirming this and no other
to be my last will and testament in Witness whereof I have here-
unto Set my hand and Seal this Nineteenth Day of January And Do

one thousand Seven hundred and Ninty Nine Publiſed and
pronounced this to be my laſt will in preſence of us
