

In the Name of God Amen I Robert Wallace of the County of Union and State of South Carolina bein in perfect mind memory and Calling to mind the Unertainty of this Life and the Mortallity of the Body do Recommend my Soul to God who gave it an my Body to the same to be Burried in a Christian Manner at the discretion of my Executors and as Trusting Such Wordly Goods as it hath pleased god to Bless me with I give and dispose of and in manner and form following Viz.

Imprimis I give and Bequeth unto my Son William all My Lands in Union County also Seven Negroes known by the names of Harry, Long Jude, old Jude, Sam, Millbry, Winn Lowden and their Increase to him and his heirs, for ever . -

Item I give unto my Step Son John Parham all my Right Tittle and Intrest to a Certain Tract of Land lying on Cape Fear River in the County of Chatham and province of North Carolina which Said Land was granted to me by his Excellency Richard Caswell then Governour and Commander in Chief over the said province anno Dom 1733 Said Land adjoining Lands now held by Said John Parham in Right of his Father John Parham Deceased also I give unto Said John parham a Certain Bay Mare known by the name of the Ham mare to him & his heirs for ever.

Item I give unto my Daughter Martha Six negroes known by the names of Sambo, Phebe, Phill, Sockey, Rose, and Peter with their Increase to her & her heirs, forever,

Item I give unto my Daughter Elizabeth Seven negroes known the names of Will, Tom, Suke James Ellock, Phillis, and Dembo, with their Increase to her and her heirs, forever -

Item I give uto Polly Ponnell only Daughter of Tabitha Pinnell Two negroes known by the names of young Sambo, and Myry With their Increase to her and her lawfull heirs begotten of her own Body forever.

But in Case She Should die without Such lawfull Issue as  
aforesaid then the Said Sambo, and Myry and their In-  
crease Shall be Equally devided between my three Children  
William Martha and Elizabeth on their heirs, also I give  
unto said Polly Pinnell as her Right and property without  
any Restrictions a good leather Bed - and furniture also  
Ten pounds Sterling in Cash the Cash to be put out at In-  
trest or used for the benefit of the said Polly Pinnell  
at the Discretion of her Mother Tabitha Pinnell.

Item It is my Will and desire that all my Lends Lying in  
Greenville and More County's in North Carolina Shall be  
Sold as Soon as my Daughter Elizabeth Shall be of the age  
of Eighteen years or Shall marry and the money to be  
Equally devided between my three Children William Martha,  
and Elizabeth or their heirs but in Case my daughter  
Elizabeth Should die before She marries or arrives at the  
age of Eighteen then my Desires is that the Said Lands  
shall be Sold as Soon as my Daughter Martha Shall be the  
age of Twenty and not sooner and be Equally devided be-  
tween the two Surviving Children or their heirs, the  
years  
Lands to be Sold at two x Credit the money to be paid at  
three different payments, Viz. one payment to be made in  
Eight months after the Sale one third more at the End of  
Sixteen Months after the Sale the Remaing third at the End  
of the two years -

Item It is my desire that my Household furniture Shall be as -  
Equally devided between my Children William Martha and  
Elizabeth as Can be done Without Selling the Same the Res-  
idue of my Personall Estate to be Sold at Twelvemonths  
Credit and the money arising from such and what Cash may  
be in hand and what debts may be due me after Collecting  
the Same Shall be Equally devided between my Children  
William Martha & Elizabeth or ~~th~~ heirs after paying what  
debts may x due from me and discharging what other gifts  
have

William Martha and Elizabeth I do also constitute and  
appoint my Freinds Frances - Deake and George Harlen  
of Union County my Son William Wallace and William  
Deake of Chatham County of No. Carolina Executors of  
this my last will and Testament Revoking and Disannul-  
ling all other wills by me formerly made in Witness  
whereof I have hereunto put my hand and Seale this day
