Item When my Daughter Lucy Fan was married I did give her three  
Negroes Namely Jude mill and Lewis which are To be appraised once  
Valued as Such a Part of her Portion Legacy or Part of my Estate  
and after my decease my desier is that my Executors have three  
negroes Valued for Each of my Children as near the Value as may  
be most Convent and if any shold not amount to the Value of the  
above named Negroes their lot must be made up in money or if  
Should overbalance the Same to be deductid once that my Children  
doth draw Lots for Choise of the said Lots of negroes & that is  
to say Namely Charles McDonald Sarah McDonald Sibelo B McDonald  
Elizabeth McDonald Jensey McDonald Robert McDonald and Matilda

Medonald Which Lot of Negroes & I give tothem and their Heirs
