givenefs for the Same I Give and Committ My Soul to Almighty
god My Saviour and Redemer In home and By home throw the Merites
of Jefus Chrifft I trust and do Belive afuredly to Be Saved and
to have a full Remifion and forgivenefs of all my Sins and
that My Soul With my Body at the genneral Day of the Refurec-
tion Shall Rife again and with Joy throw the merrites of Jefus
Chrift Death and poffion poffefs and Inherit the kingdom of
heavn prepared for his Elect and Chosen and my Body to Be Burred
in Puch a place where it Shall pleafe My Executors hereafter
Mentioned to Apoint and for The Seteling of my temporal Eftate
of Such Goods & Chattels and Lands and Debtes as it heath
pleased God to Beftow to me & firft I do Give and Difpoe the
Same in the menner and form following & that ifto Say first all
Debts due and Lawfull Demand that I owe to aney perfon or per-
sons whatsoever Shall Be Complied with and paid or ordered to
Be paid within Convenient time after my Deceas By my Executors
hereafter named toom I Give and Bequeth one Shilling Sterling to
my Son william young Likewise I Give and Bequeth to my Son
George Young one Shilling Starling Laftly I do Give and
Bequith to my Well Beloved Wife Catterin young the hole of all
my Goods and Chattels and household furnature Debts dues and

demand whatsoever and Likewise my Land hir Lifetime Which Land
I after hir Decease I order to Be given to my youngest Son Chrif-
tephor young my hole and Seal Executor in testemoney Whereof I
have hereunto Set my hand and Seal the day and Dede above writ-
ten
