I William Blackstock of Union County and State Aforesaid being of Sound and Discreet Mind Memory and Reasonable and Publish this my last Will and Testament of the worldly Estate which God has been Pleased to Bless me with this 19th Day of Sept A D 1788 in manner and form following Viz: After all my just Debts and funeral Charges are fully Satisfied and paid I give and Bequeath unto my Beloved Wife Euphemy and her Heirs and Assigns forever My New Feather Bed together with One Spotted Coverlet One Blanket and Two Sheets belonging to the Same the whole of her wearing Apperal my young dark Bay Pacing Mare and my Three year Old Bright Bay Pacing Mare Also all the Cows my Said Wife fetched me together with their Increase the Third Part of this Years Crap raised on my Plantation my little Widdler and Big Ewe all the Woal and Yarnin the House all my Fuse half my Hoggs her Side Saddle and Planwheel Chaf Bid all my Kitchen Furniture except the great Pott Tea Furniture four Pewter and Three Earthen Plates all my Spoons Knives and Forks Two Tin Cups One Breed Bowl my New Testament Leather for four Pair of Shoes the--dried Peaches and Salt the Bolster of Feathers the Straw Baskets four Chairs five Quant Bottles the Weaving--Loom with Harness & belonging to the Same my Barshier Plow Two Hoes and Smothing Iron and Two Axis also the Use of the Plantation untill May Next, I Also give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Margret Beard and her Heirs and Assigns forever my Old Feather Bed with the Pillows Bolster and Two Blankets One Cow and Calf my Big Pott my bald Horse Leather for four Pairs of Shoes I Also give and Bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Beard and her Heirs and Assigns

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forever the Bed and Cow and Calf which I lent her Also an other Cow and Calf Two Blankets my Chest I Also give and Bequeath unto my Son William His Heirs and Assigns forever One Cow and Calf my Riffle Gun and Thirty Pounds Sterling Money in good Trade which my Son James must Pay him out of the Value of my

Plantation I Also give and Bequeath unto my Grand Son John Blackstock My big Hiffer and Little Eve my Silver Buckles my Duch Plow One Pair ~~and~~ and Ax-I also give and Bequeath unto my Grand Daughter Ruth Blackstock my Yearling Hiffer I also give and Bequeath unto my Son James His Heirs and Assigns forever All the Residue of my Personal Estate not mentioned above also my Plantation on which I now live Out of which he is to pay my Funeral charges and Other just Debts and also Pay my Son William his Heirs or Assigns the Thirty Pound Sterling Money in good Trade above mentioned And lastly I do hereby Nominate and Appoint my aforesaid Son James Executor of this my last Will and Testament. And Do hereby declare all former Wills by me at any time heretofore made to be Void and Null and this to be my last and only Will Signed Sealed Published and

Declared by the aforementioned William Blackstock to be his last Will and Testament
