

In the name of God Amen, I William Plummer of Union County in the State of South Carolina Being in good health and of a perfect and Sound mind and memory thanks to God therefore Calling to mind the mortality of my Body and that it is appointed for all men Come to Die do make Constitute and ordain this my last Will and Testament that is to Say Principally and first of all I give and recommend my Soul into the hands of Almighty god That at first gave it, and for my Body I recommend it to the Earth to be Buried in a Christian Like and Decent manner at the discretion of my Executors nothing doubting But at the General Resurrection I Shall receive the Same again By the Mighty Power of God, and as Touching Such Worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased god to Bless me in this Life I give Devise and Dispose of the Same in the following Manner and form.*****

Imprimis I give and Bequeath unto my well Beloved wife all and Singular my Lands and Tenements To have hold and Enjoy the same So Long as She Shall Live, and remain my widow Bearing my name

Item-I Give and Bequeath to My Well Beloved Christen Plummer All my Household goods and Moveable and personal property with all my moneys Either Due to me at in possession that is to Say after all my Funeral Expences and all other just debts are paid and discharged provided and on Conditionals That She Shall pay out of the Said Moneys and of my Estate within twelve months after my Decease The Sum of thirty Pounds Sterling unto Melon Wood the Son of Peggey Wood-----

And I do give and Bequeath the Sum of thirty Pound as aforesaid unto the Said Melon Wood

Item- My will is further that after the Decease fo my Said wife Christen Plummer or as Soon as She Shall marry That all my Lands Beforementioned Shall Immediately Be appirised By Three honest Sponsibile Indifferient free holder to Bee Chosen By the Exe-

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cutors of this my will and the Same Shall Be fairly Set up and
Sold at publick Vendue to the highest Bidder Giving twelve
months Credit with Sufficient and approved Security taken for
the Same And I do hereby Authorize Constitute ordain and Impair-

The Executors of this will hereafter to names to sell confirm

Convey and make good and Sufficient right to all my Said Lands in The manner and form Before mentioned-----

Item-My will is further that the Sum of money for which My Land Shall Be Sold as aforesaid Shall Be Collected together and I give and Bequeath the Sum of twenty five pound Sterling of the Same Unto My Loveing Sister Rebekah Moore-----

Item- That all the remainder of the Said moneys Shall Be Divided into two Equal Parts And I give and Bequeath the one Equal half part thereof to my well Beloved Brother Thomas Plummer living in Lancaster County in the State of Pennsylvania or if he Die Before He Shall receiv the Same my will is that his Eldst Son Shall receive and Enjoy the Same-----

Item- My will is that the other half part of the money above mentioned in Selling the Land Shall Begiven to My Living Brother Daniel Plummer or if he decease Before receives it I give and Bequeath the Same Sum of money to his Daughter Elenor Pritchett

Item-My Will is further that all the Movable Estate heretofore mentioned whatever Shall remain Untill the Decease of My Said wife Christen Plummer that She do Cause it to Be Equially Divided and the one half Be given to her Brother Moses Collyer and the other Equal half Begiven to my Nephew Alein Cox ^{or} x to his heirs-----

And I do Constitute ordain and appoint my well Beloved wife Christen Plummer and my Two trusty and Beloved friends George Harlan Hatter and Aaron Fincher to Be the-----Executors of This my Last Will and Testament-----

And I do here by utterly disallow revoke and Dicanul all other former Testaments Wills Logreys and Executors By me in Anywise Before this time made Framed Willed and Bequeathed Ratifying and Confirming this and no other to Be my last Will and Testament-----

In Witness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and affixed my Seal this ninth Day of august In the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and ninety one-----
