And I do give and Bequeath the Sum of thirty Pound as aforesaid unto the Said Melon Wood

Item- My will is further that after the Decease fo my Said wife Christen Plummer or as Soon as She Shall marry That all my Lands Beforementioned Shall Immediately Be apprised By Three honest Sponsable Indifferent free holder to Bee Chosen by the Exe-

rect and Sound mind and memory thanks to God therefore calling

Item- My will is further that after the Decease fo my Said wife
Christen Plummer or as Soon as She Shall marry That all my Lands
Beforementioned Shall Immediately Be apprised By Three honest
Sponsible Indifferent free holder to Bee Chosen By the Exe-
cutors of this my will and the Same Shall Be fairly Set up and
Sold at publick Vendue to the highest Bidder Giving twelve
months Credit with Sufficient and approved Security taken for
the Same And I do hereby Authorize Constitute ordain and Impair-

The Executors of this will hereafter to names to self confirm

Convey and make good and Sufficient right to all my Said Lands
in The manner and form Before mentioned-----

Item- My will is further that the Sum of money for which My Land
Shall Be Sold as aforesaid Shall Be Collected together and I
give and Bequeath the Sum of twenty five pound Sterling of the
Same Unto My Loveing Sister Rebekah Moore-----

Item- That all the remainder of the Said moneys Shall Be Divi-
ded into two Equal Parts And I give and Bequeath the one Equal
half part thereof to my well Beloved Brother Thomas Plummer liv-
ing in Lancaster County in the State of Pennsylvania or if he
Die Before He Shall receiv the Same my will is that his Eldst
Son Shall receive and Enjoy the Same-----

Item- My will is that the other half part of the money above
mentioned in Selling the Land Shall Begiven to My Living Brother
Daniel Plummer or if he decease Before receives it I give and
Bequeath the Same Sum of money to his Daughter Elenor Pritchett

Item- My Will is further that all the Movable Estate heretofore
mentioned whatever Shall remain Until the Decease of My Said
wife Christen Plummer that She do Cause it to Be Equally Divi-
ded and the one half Be given to her Brother Moses Collyer and
the other Equal half Begiven to my Nephew Alein Cox ^{or} x to his
heirs-----

And I do Constitute ordain and appoint my well Beloved wife
Christen Plummer and my Two trusty and Beloved friends George
Harlan Hatter and Aaron Fincher to Be the----Executors of This
my Last Will and Testament-----

And I do here by utterly disallow revoke and Disanul all other
former Testaments Wills Legreys and Executors By me in Anywise
Before this time made Framed Willed and Bequeathed Ratifying
and Confirming this and no other to Be my last Will and Testa-
ment-----
