In the name of God Amen . I Abner Brown of the State of South Carolina Williamsburgh District Planter, being in health of body & of sound mind Memory & understanding.

~~praised be God for the same~~ do make this my last Will & Testament in Manner & form following-----

I give devise & bequeath unto my beloved Wife Jannet Brown the use & benefit of all my Real & personal Estate during her widowhood & no longer, wishing her to live on my Plantation with my children, with the exception of Two Hundred & Fifty dollars which I give to each of my Grand Children Mary Jane Patterson, & Robert Patterson, to be paid out of my Estate by my Executors as they arrive to the age of Twenty one years, or marriage, but in case either of my grand children should die without leaving any Issue that then the surviving grand child shall be entitled to that portion of the deceased child's part. but in case both die without leaving living Issue then their part or parts shall go to my surviving son. It is my Will & desire that at the death of my wife, or widowhood (should she hereafter marry) that all my Estate both Real & personal left to her, shall go to my surviving sons, or their Issue should any of them be dead, that is, the Issue of a deceased son to take, or have, that part or portion which their parent would have been entitled too had he been living. with this exception that my son

William is to receive Sixty dollars - than either of my sons
Lastly I do nominate Coconstitute & appoint my Wife Jannet Executrix & Wm. H. Brown Asa E. Brown Samuel J. Tisdale & John J Tisdale Executors of this my last Will & Testament giving them full power to execute the same, also full power & authority to give off to each of my heirs their part or share of my Estate
