Philes and Amey to her the said Sarah Clark for ever with the future ishue and increase of the said Philes and Amey for ever but in case ~~the said Sarah Clark should die not having a lawful heir my will~~ is that it go and Desend to my Brother John Clark to him and his heirs lawfully begotten for Ever. I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my Mother Sarah Clark and James Bland Executor and Executrix of this my last will and testament Revoking all former wills and wills by me at any time maid and Declaring this to be My last will ⁱⁿ and testament in testimony whereof I the said Alexander Clark have here unto set my hand and seal this day of January one thousand Eight hundred and two and in the twenty six years of American Independece.
