State of South Carolina, Williamsburgh Dist) In the name of God Amen, this 13th Day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight Hundred and sixteen, I Andrew Watson of the District and State afore-said ^B being weak in ^B body but yet of Perfect, mind, memory, and understanding but calling to mind the Mortality of my Body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my last Will and testament that ^S in principally and first of all, I ^{re} commend my Soul to God who gave it, my Body I ^{re} commend to the Earth, to be buried in a decent and Christian manner at the discretion of my Executors, ~~nothing~~ doubting but I shall receive the same again, at the General Resurrection, by the Almighty Power of God and as touching such Worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to ^B bless me with in this Life. I demise & bequeath in manner and form following - Imprimis, I order all my just debts and Funeral Charges to be paid out of my estate - Item, I will and bequeath unto my Brother John Watson all my part of a tract of Land lying on Santee, in Sumpter District, and all my part of a tract lying on the South East Side of the ^R road leading from Murrays ferry to the Lower Bridge - Item I will and bequeath to my Nephew John Watson all my other possessions of lands, or real estate, lying on Thorntree and the waters thereof, with all my stock of Horses, Cattle, and hogs, and sheep, together with my fire arms, Item, I will and bequeath to my Nephew John Watson, and my Neice Sarah Ann Watson, all my Negroes, namely Sam, Billy Sarah, and Ben, and my house hold and kit-

body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to
 die do make and ordain this my last will and testament
 that in^s principally and first of all, I^{re} commend my Soul to
 God who gave it, my Body I^{re} commend to the Earth, to be bur-
 ied in a decent and Christian manner at the discretion of
 my executors, nothing doubting but I shall receive the same
 again, at the General Resurrection, by the Almighty Power of
 God and as touching such Worldly Estate wherewith it has
 pleased God to bless me with in this life. I demise & be-
 queath in manner and form following - Imprimis, I order
 all my just debts and Funeral Charges to be paid out of my
 estate - Item, I will and bequeath unto my Brother John
 Watson all my part of a tract of Land lying on Santee, in
 Sumpter District, and all my part of a tract lying on the
 South East Side of the road leading from Murrays ferry to
 the Lower Bridge - Item I will and bequeath to my Nephew
 John Watson all my other possessions of lands, or real
 estate, lying on Thorntree and the waters thereof, with all
 my stock of Horses, Cattle, and hogs, and sheep, together
 with my fire arms, Item, I will and bequeath to my Nephew
 John Watson, and my Neice Sarah Ann Watson, all my Negroes,
 namely Sam, Billy Sarah, and Ben, and my house hold and kit-
 chen furniture, to be Equally divided between them when my
 said Nephew John arrives at age, or when my Neice Sarah Ann,
 arrives at age or marries, It is my will and desire that my
 Nephew John should take possession of his property at the age
 of Twenty one years or marries - And I do hereby nominate
 and appoint my Brother John Watson, and William Salters
 executors of my last will and testament - In testimony where-
 of I have hereunto set my hand and Seal, the day and year
