

WILL OF ANN M^CCants.

In the name of God Amen I Ann M^CCants of Williamsburgh District Widow being of sound & disposing mind & memory praised be to god for the same do make Ordain & declare this my last will & Testament in manner & form following that is to say

Item I give & bequeath to the Children of my son James M^C-Cants thirty dollars to be equally divided between ^{them} as their full part or share of my estate

Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Jane M^CKnuly thirty dollars as her full part or ^gshare of my estate-

Item I give & bequeath to my son Robert M^CCants one negro woman named Nanny & her future increase to him & his Issue lawfully begotten for ever.

Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Jannet Brown one negro ^{Increase} women named Nancy & her future to her & her Issue lawfully begotten for ever.

Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Sarah Murphy Two negroes named Doll & her child Amanda & their future Increase during her natural life & at her death to go to the Children of John M^CLaulin to be equally divided between them or as many of them as may be alive at the death of their Mother (Sarah Murphy) Lastly it is my will & disere that the Remaining negro Lizza not named above shall be sold, as also, all the Remainder & Residu of my estate by Executors as soon as it may be Convenient after my death & my funeral expences & all my Just debts to be first paid and my daughter Jane M^CKnuly & my son James M^CCants Children Receive the amount of their Legacy out of the money arising from the said sale and the balance or Remainder of money arising from such sale shall be equally divided between my three Children Robert M^CCants,

Item I give & bequeath to the Children of my son James M^c-
 Cants thirty dollars to be equally divided between them
 as
 their full part or share of my estate

Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Jane M^cKnuly thirty
 dollars as her full part or share of my estate-

Item I give & bequeath to my son Robert M^cCants one negro
 woman named Nanny & her future increase to him & his Issue
 lawfully begotten for ever.

Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Jannet Brown one negro
 Increase
 woman named Nancy & her future to her & her Issue
 lawfully begotten for ever.

Item I give & bequeath to my daughter Sarah Murphy Two negroes
 named Doll & her child Amanda & their future Increase during
 her natural life & at her death to go to the Children of
 John M^cLaulin to be equally divided between them or as many
 of them as may be alive at the death of their Mother (Sarah
 Murphy) Lastly it is my will & disere that the Remaining
 negro Lizza not named above shall be sold, as also, all the
 Remainder & Residu of my estate by Executors as soon as it
 may be Convenient after my death & my funeral expences & all
 my Just debts to be first paid and my daughter Jane M^cKnuly
 & my son James M^cCants Children Receive the amount of their
 Legacy out of the money arising from the said sale and the bal-
 lance or Remainder of money arising from such sale shall be

Lastly I nominate Constitute & appoint Abner Brown & James
 M^cFaddin Executors of this my last will & Testament giving
 them full power to execute the same In witness whereof I
 have hereunto set my hand, & Seal this 17th day June 1823
