In the name of God Amen I Benjamin Turner of the s'd State & Dst afores'd find my Self very Low and weak in body nowing that It is once appointed for all Men to Die finding myself in perfect mind& memery and wish to Dispose of my Property where are with God hath been pleased to bles me with In the following manner nameing my Dearly beloved wife Phebey Turner to have my Plantation and Plantation tooles and also a third part of my property During her Life time or widow hood and then to Returne to my Estateand then to be equally divided between them all I gave unto my son Reubin Turner too cows and caves and Bed I also gave unto my son Hugh Turner too cowes and calves and Bed---- I also give to the Remainer of my sons Two Cowes and calves and Bed as they come of Age or Marry (It is my Desire that all my Lawfull Dets should be paid) I do Leave all Estate to the care of Reubin Turner & Benjamin Turner and Joint Excuters there of any will or wills by me maid before this shall be void and of no effect But this to be and Remain in full force power and virture in Law in wittneSsing there of here unto Set my hand seald this Day and This the third day of January 1821 year above within signd seald an delivered in the presents of viz Test.
