Mary I give and Bequeath One Dollar and Twenty Five Cents Also
To my son Peter I give and Bequeath One Dollar and Twenty Five
Cents---And Lastly I Give and Bequeath unto my Beloved wife all
the Remainder of my Real and personal ^{Estate} X During her Natural Life
or Widow hood and after her Death or widowhood---I give and De-
vise the Same to my son John McKensey for Ever-----

And make my Loving Friends Thomas Rose and W^m Kennedy my Execu-
tors of this my Last will to take care & see the Same performed
According to my True Intent and meaning-----In witness where
of I the Said Daniel McKensey have to this my Last will and
Tesement Set my hand and Seal the Day and Year Above written--
Signed sealed and published by the said Daniel McKensey as and
for his Last Will and Testament in the presence of us who were
present at the Signing and Sealing thereof
