I David I Wilson of the County of Lowndes and State of Mississippi being weak and debilitated of body but of sound mind and disposing memory (thanks be to God) and being impressed with the certainty of death and the great uncertainty of life and being anxious to leave my affairs so arranged as to give the least trouble and expense in settling my Estate according to my wish do make and publish this my last Will and testament in the manner and form following viz.--- First It is my Will and desire that all my just debts be paid and should my beloved wife Jane prove to be in a family way and should be delivered of a living child--- It is my will and desire that all my Estate remaining should be equally divided between her and her child and should she not be blessed with a child then in that Event I will and desire that she shall have two thirds of all my property remaining after paying my debts----- The other third I will to be equally divided between my brother John Wilson now supposed to be living and the Estate of Robert I. Wilson Dec^d and the children of my sister Mary Wilson wife of David E Wilson----- And I will and appoint my ~~brother~~ beloved wife Jane Wilson and my Brother John M Ervin and James W Ervin in whom I have the most implicit confidence my Executors and Executors to this my last Will and Testament. Given under my hand and seal this 20th August 1839
