of land ~~in~~ that he lately purchased, the Land now wheen I now  
live and the negroes to be kept to-gather a stock of hoggs to  
be sold Except six sows a stock of Cattells to be sold Except  
Eight Cow and Calf the tract nex to Marlow som Careful person  
to be employd to Superentend to take Care of the plantation  
wheon I now live five bails of Cotten with Conne magwood to be  
sold the Libery to be sold with all the Books given under my hand  
seal this 19 Day of February 1813

my Estate
