I leav fillis and nan and Judy free Leving each of them fifty achors of Land Joining Childns Land my Larg Servay between Clap swamp and kingstree swamp to be sole tittle to be maid to Danel Frierson for a tract of land ~~in~~ that he lately purchased, the Land now wheen I now live and the negroes to be kept to-gather a stock of hogges to be sold Except six sows a stock of Cattells to be sold Except Eight Cow and Calf the tract nex to Marlow som Cearfule person to be imployd to Superentend to take Cear of the plantation wheen I now live five balls of Cotten With Conne magwood to be Sold the Libery to be sold with all the Books given under my ~~hand~~ hand seal this 19 Day of Febuary 1813

I hereby I apoint John hickson and Thomas Steale my Exactors to my Estate
