

J. Eaddy of the State & District afore Said Being Feeble in
Body but in Sound mind & Judgement Thanks be to God for the
same, do make and ordain this my Last Will and Testament in
the manner and form following Viz, first I give & bequeath
to my beloved wife Zilpha Eaddy The Tract of Land which I
now live on (including) the Plantation, during her natural
natural Life, and at her death to return Back to my Child-
ren, also my feather Bed on which I lie with necessary furni-
ture I give to her forever also the Cattle which I got by
her in marriage I give to her for Ever, also my young Mare
called Ribbon I Lend to my wife her natural life and at her
death to Return to my Children, also I lend to my wife
Zilpha Eaddy all my Negro property during her life, Except
the Girl vine, Richard to be hired out every year if thought
advisable by my Executors for the Benefit of my wife, and
the other negroes to be Kept on the plantation and wife to
live on the Entire Proceeds, and the death of my wife all
the Negroes that there is at that time to be Sold, and the
Proceeds to be Equally divided Between all my Children, and
Sarah Bartete Children to Receive the share of their mother
& Legett Bowels, Children to Receive the Share of their
mother, & Brily H. Stone Frances Bartete Margaret Eaddy &
William J Stone, to have an Equal Share of the Proceeds of
the Negroes, with my Children I give and bequeath unto the
Children of my Deceased Daughter Ligett Powell the Plana-
tion or tract of Land containing one hundred & sixty acres
or less wherein Levi E Powell now lives for Ever. I also
will the Tract of Tract of Land Containing Three Hundred
Acres Lying on the South Side of Lynches Creek surveyed for
William Parsons to be reserved for Range & privilege for
my Children---and as for the Balance of all my Perishable
Property of Every description I instruct my Executors to
make sale of it and also the Negro girl vine, and after pay-

my Funeral Expenses and all Just debts to Reserve Enough to give my Two Sons Gregory and Clark Each Three months schooling and my Son Oliver one years Schooling -- and if there be a Balance it is to be Equally Divided Between my children & Letete Powells children to Receive their mothers share, as for the Balance of my Real Estate I wish it to remain undivided until my youngest child comes of age & if any of my Children wishes to settle on any Part of my Land I wish them to have the privilege, and at the time the youngest child comes of age my Lands to be divided or sold for a division and the Proceeds to be Equally divided between my Children Letete Powells Children to Receive their mothers Share, But the Tract of Land which I have Given them to be valued at Seventy Dollars and Shall be taken by them as that amount of their Share, and I do hereby Empower and intrust my Executors to retain and Keep in hand the share of Letete Powells Children until they become of sufficient age to manage for them Selves, Except, the Interest of their share which I wish to be applied to their ; as often as my Executors find it necessary----and I do hereby nominate and appoint my Two Sons Martin & Tailor Eaddy Sole Executors of my last will and Testament revoking all other Wills and Former Wills by me at any made heretofore---in Witness Whereof I have hereunto Set my hand "eal this Twenty seventh day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred & forty eight signed Sealed published and Declared by Edward D. Eaddy to be his Last will and Testament in the Presence of us who have hereunto subscribed our names as Witnesses to the same in the Presence of the Testator
