Hewit my white sow and pigs, I give and bequeath to Anna Hewit my two white sows and pigs five shoats, I give and bequeath to my Aunt Mary Hewit Thirteen year old shoats, I will and bequeath to Eliza M Hewit my two trunks and coony. I give and bequeath to my Aunt Mary Hewit all my Kitchen furniture I give and bequeath to John G. Hewit all my wearing apparel. I will and bequeath to John G. Hewit my saddle & bridle I will & bequeath to Eliza M Hewit one string of Gold Beads one pair of year rings and gold finger ring it is my will and desire that I wish all my lawful debts paid out of my wages for overseeing for my aunt M. Hewit and the ballance if any there is I wish my Executors to make an Equal divide of it among my aunt Marys children; I appoint and nominate Uncle William I Burrows Executor and Aunt Mary Hewit Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 21st of September in the year of our Lord 1820.
