State of South Carolina In the name of God Amen I
Elizabeth Douglass of the District of Williamburgh and State
aforesaid being weak in body but of a sound and disposing mind
and memory thanks to God for the same do make and ordain this to
be my last will and testament in manner and form as follows
first it is My will and desire that all my lawful debt be paid
and then I give and bequeath to My beloved Mother Rebecca
Smith My hole Estate during her Natural life Consisting of
a Stock of Cattle Hogs Household and kitchen furniture and
also My Plantation or tract of land wheron I now reside and
after her death I give and bequeath to my Sister Mary Davis
one fether bed and after her death I give and bequeath said
fether bed to her son Jehu P Davis I also give and bequeath
to My sister Sarah Courtney one feather bed I also give and
bequeath to My Brother Mem W. Smith one Hand mill the ball-
ance of My Estate not herein mentioned to be appressed and
divide in four Equal parts the Lands I give and bequeath
to My two sisters Mary Davis and Sarah Courtney and if when
apprased it should amount to more than one half of My hole
Estate they shall pay over to tesse who shall hereafter be
mentioned as it is My will and desire that they shall all
be made equal it is My will and desire after the death of
my sister Mary Davis that that portion of land that falls
to her to go to her son Thomas H. Davis and that portion
which falls to My sister Sarah Courtney after her Death
I give and bequeath to Her Daughter Margaret Courtney the
ballance of My Estate herein mentioned and not otherwise
disposed of Consisting of a stock of Cattle Hogs Household
and Kitchen furniture to be equally divided in two parts
