All the rest, residue, and remainder of my estate and effects, of what nature or kind soever. I give devise and bequeath unto my Six children Viz Robert W James, Mary E Green, John T James, William E James Elizabeth James and Sarah A James their heirs executors administrators and assigns, to be equally divided amongst them share and share alike. And I do hereby nominate <sup>constitute</sup> and appoint my two sons John T and William E James and my son in law Samuel Green, Executors of this my last will and testament; In witness whereof I have hereunto Set my hand and Seal. this Tenth day of July. in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and twenty six Signed sealed published pronounced & declared by the said Elizabeth James To be her last will and testament in the presence of the subscribers -----
