Fluitt the following negroes Viz Dewey, Gillet & Mary with their increase to them and their heirs forever ----- Lastly I Constitute and appoint my Son James G M<sup>c</sup>Gill Executor and my daughter Mary M<sup>c</sup>Clary Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament -- and do hereby revoke and disannul all former will or Wills by me made Confirming this and this alone to be my last Will and Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my my hand and seal this Second day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty nine and in the fifty fourth year of American Independence -----
