st 1st It is my Will and desire that Samuel Alexander Knox have the whole of my property both Real and personal and I do hereby give and bequeath to him the following Negroes with their increase viz Machel, Crecy, Tom Mascus, Anny, Sue, Lucy, Will, Mosey, Jim also my stock of every description household and kitchen furniture

nd 2nd and I do Will and bequeath to him the whole of my Real Estate -- WitneSS my hand and seal this 31st day of July in the year of our Lord 1830
