

WILL OF ELIZABETH WILSON.

In the name of God, Amen. I Elizabeth Wilson of Williamsburg District State of South Carolina, Widow. Being at this time duely possessed of a sound and disposing mind, in a frail diseased body, which calls to mind its mortality: do therefore make this my last Will and Testament as follows.

I commend my Soul to God: and desire my Executors to have my Body buried in the Earth in a decent and Christian manner at their discretion; and next pay all my Just and lawful debts out of my Estate. The remainder thereof I give and devise as follows. I give and devise unto my son John Wilson of North Carolina One hundred dollars to be paid at my decease. I give and devise unto my three grand children Elizabeth M^c Wilson, Martha Wilson and Robert D. Wilson children of my said son John Wilson by his former wife Jane One hundred dollars to be equally divided share and share alike between said three. Elizabeth M^c to get her part paid her at my decease. Martha & Robert D. each one of them to get their part of it on the day of their marriage or then when they arrive at the age of Twenty one years. I give and devise unto my son Robert Wilson in the State of Louisiana Two dollars to be paid at my decease. All and every part, of the residue of my personal Estate whatever it may be, or however distinguished by name in the Courts of Law of this State. I give and devise in equal proportions or parts share and share alike between my three surviving children; that is to say my daughter Elizabeth James and her husband John James one equal third part, and their lawful heirs forever. To my son David Wilson him and his lawful heirs another equal ^{third} part forever. To my son Samuel J. Wilson him and his lawful heirs the remaining

voke and disannul all former Wills Testaments and Bequeath by

me in any wise made before; and ratify and confirm this and
no other to be my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof

of January ---- In the year of our Lord One Thousand, Eight
hundred and Twenty Two. -----
