In the name of God Amen I Francis Walsh of Williamsburgh  
District & State of South Carolina & native of Ireland being  
of Sound mind & Memory--- do make & ordain this my last Will  
& Testament in the manner following to Witt

1st. I will that all my just & Lawfull Debts be paid as soon  
as possible---2nd. I leave & bequeath to My Nephew Francis

Walsh Son of Thos---Walsh, Fifteen Hundred Dollars. with In-  
terest from the date of my Death until paid which I wish as

soon as possible. 3rd I leave & bequeath to Jane Commick se-  
cond Daughter of Patrick Commick Fifteen Hundred Dollars- with

Inter- from the date of My Deaths to be put out to best advan-  
tage for her. Education & in case of the death of either Francis

Walsh son of Thos--- or Jane Commick Daughter of Patrick I wish  
that the d.<sup>ce</sup> fifteen Hundred Dollars be divided equally among

the surviving children of s<sup>d</sup> Thos & in like manner among the  
s<sup>d</sup> children of s<sup>d</sup> Patrick Commick. 4th I leave & bequeath to my

son which I had by a young woman in Ireland known by the name  
of Biddy & the s<sup>d</sup> child I expect is at my brother Toms-----

Five Hundred Dollars- to give him schooling & in case of his  
Death. it shall refer to my Brother Tom children share & share  
alike- The rest residue & remainder of all I die posseses off.

I leave to my brother Thomas Walsh & Patrick Commick son of  
Rich<sup>d</sup> Commick. Share & Share alike I wish no suit at Law but

a fair construction on this my last will & Testament, in  
witness whereof I have put my hand & seal this 24th day of July  
1817---- & the forty fifth year of the Independence of america--
