The Thirtieth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and Sixteen- I Gaven Witherspoon of Williamsburgh District, in the State aforesaid, being weak of body but of perfect mind, memory, & understanding, yet calling to mind the mortality of my ^B body, & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make & ordain this to be my last Will & Testament--Principally & first of all I recommend my ^S soul into the hands of God who gave it, not doubting but I shall receive the same again at the general Resurrection, by the mighty power of God-- My body I recommend to the Earth, to be buried in a decent christian manner, at the discretion of my Executors, and as touching such Worlaly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I demise & bequeath in the maner & form following I order all my Just debts & funeral charges to be paid out of my Estate-- Item-- I will & bequeath unto the children of my Daughter Jennet, & to the Children of my Son Robert Pinkney & to my Son Samuel & to my Daughter Elizabeth one dollar each, which with the Land, Negroes & other property I gave them at marriage I deem their full share of my Estate both real & personal-- I will & bequeath to my Son Thomas Reece, all that plantation or Tract of Land containing Four hundred acres originally granted to John Robertson situate on each side of thorn tree ^S Swamp & adjoins the tract on which I lise, also too Lots of land of half an ^L acre each in the Town of Williamsburgh--Item--I will & be-

divided between my three Children Last mentioned & provided
for in this last clause of my Will--Item--Lastly--I nominate
& appoint my Son Thomas Reece & my Son John Milton (when of

Guardian of my Children, & I do hereby disanull & make void
all former, Wills, Testaments & Legacies & bequeaths what-
soever confirming this to be my last Will & Testament, in
testimony whereof I have hereunto Set my hand & Seal the day
