Keels (planter) of Williamsburgh District being of sound disposing mind and memory But weak in body do make and ordain this my last will and testament revoking all other will or wills by me heretofore made Imprimis I give and bequeath unto Elsy and her three Children Johnson Frances and George their freedom also Twenty head stock Cattle my stock hogs the plantation or tract of land whereon they now reside and the household & Kitchen furniture which an on said plantation with a request that my Executors hereafter named shall endeavor to have their freedom established --

Item I give and bequeath unto my beloved daughter Julia Susanah Keels all the rest and residue of my Estate both real and personal and Lastly I do Constitute nominate and appoint my worthy friends, Morgan Sabb Perter U. Oliver and Robert. G.
