Lastly I nominate and appoint Hugh McCutchen George McCutchen and George Barr Executors of this my last will and testament and give them full power to pay my lawful debts and to collect any debts due to me In witness whereof I have hereto subscribed my name and fixed my seal this first day of July one thousand eight hundred and twenty six and in the fifteenth year of American Independence---
