South Carolina,--

In the name of God amen.

I Hannah Paisley, of Williamsburgh District, in the State afore-  
said Widow, being sick and weak, in body, but of sound, mind,  
memory, and understanding, thanks be to God for the same; but  
calling to mind the certainty of death, and the uncertainty of  
the time when it may happen, have thought proper to make distri-  
bution of and settle my wourldly affairs in the following  
manner Viz. 1st. I will, devise, and bequeath, to my Daughter  
Sarah Gamble, wife of William Gamble, that parcel or tract of &  
land whereon I now reside containing thirty acres, more or less  
being part of a tract of land--now owned by David McClary but  
granted to me, by the late John Dickey Esquire, together with  
the buildings and other improvements thereon; which said land  
buildings &c, I will and devise to my said Daughter Sarah  
Gamble and to her lawful Issue forever, 2nd. I will and bequeath  
to my Granddaughter Sarah Hannah Adeline Mathews, a Negro Girl  
named Setira---

3rd. I will and bequeath to my grandson Samuel McGill Gamble,  
a negro boy named Stephen,---

4thly I will and bequeath to my Grandson Samuel McGill Matthews  
a negro boy named Antony-----

5thly I will devise and bequeath to my Daughter Susannah Matthe-  
ws, wife of John Matthews Jr. and to her lawful Issue, the  
following negroes Viz. Eley, Judy, Nero, Ceasar, Jolly, Mosey,  
Rose and her two children Luis, and Mary Ann,-----

6thly I also will devise and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah  
Gamble and to her lawful Issue, the following Negroes. Viz,

the time when it may happen, have thought proper to make distribution of and settle my worldly affairs in the following manner Viz. 1st. I will, devise, and bequeath, to my Daughter Sarah Gamble, wife of William Gamble, that parcel or tract of land whereon I now reside containing thirty acres, more or less being part of a tract of land--now owned by David McClary but granted to me, by the late John Dickey Require, together with the buildings and other improvements thereon; which said land buildings &c, I will and devise to my said Daughter Sarah Gamble and to her lawful issue forever, 2nd. I will and bequeath to my Granddaughter Sarah Hannah Adeline Mathews, a Negro Girl named Setira---

3rd. I will and bequeath to my grandson Samuel McGill Gamble, a negro boy named Stephen,---

4thly I will and bequeath to my Grandson Samuel McGill Matthews a negro boy named Antony-----

5thly I will devise and bequeath to my Daughter Susannah Matthews, wife of John Matthews Jr. and to her lawful issue, the following negroes Viz. Eley, Judy, Nero, Ceasar, Jolly, Mosey, Rose and her two children Luis, and Mary Ann,-----

6thly I also will devise and bequeath to my Daughter Sarah Gamble and to her lawful issue, the following Negroes. Viz, Doll, and her five children named China, Dolly, Sam, Jenny, and Sharper Also Pegg and her three children, named Mireah, Lucinda, and Isaac, also a Young negro man named Harry, and a boy named January; And if after a fair valuation it be found that the Negroes above willed to my two Daughters aforesaid, should be unequal in value, then it is my will and desire that the one having the greatest, shall pay over to the one having the least portion, so as to make both portions equal; And all

the rest residue and remainder of my Estate wheather real or personal, I give devise and bequeath to be equally divided between my aforesaid two Daughters Susannah Matthews and Sarah Gamble and to their heirs; lastly I constitute nominate and appoint Samuel R Mouzon, Johnr Matthews Jr. and William Taylor of Sumter District Executors of this my last will and testament here by revoking and disanuling all and every will or wills by me at any time hereto fore made declaring and confirming this and no other to be my last will and Testament, In witness whereof I have hereunto affixed my seal and subscribed my name this twentieth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen, and of American Independence the Fortieth-----
