I Henry Price of South Carolina Williamsburgh County being  
sick and weak in body, but of perfect mind and memory; thanks  
be to God therefore, but calling to mind the Mortality of my  
body and knowing its appointed for all men once to die, do make  
and ordain this my last will & testament, that is principally  
& first of all I give & recommend my Soul to Almighty God that  
gave it, and for my body I give & recommend it unto the Earth  
to be buried in a decent Christian like manner at the dis-  
cretion of my Executor herein after named, and as for my world-  
ly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with in this  
life I give and dispose of the same in manner and form follow-  
ing. that is to say My Funeral charges and all my lawful  
and Just debts be paid in convenient time after my death, and  
the legacies herein After bequeathed are to be discharged as  
soon as circumstances will permit, and in the manner directed--  
Item. I give and bequeath unto my dear & beloved wife Margaret  
Two tracts of land, one tract containing two Hundred Acres the  
other tract of one Hundred acres adjoining the same to her  
during her life time and at her death to go to her son William  
McFaddin & his heirs for Ever. Item I gave & bequeath unto my  
said wife three negroes named Bob Silvy & Jow, also my stock  
of horses cattle & hoggs during her life time & at her decease  
the negroes horses & cattle are to go to Hugh McFaddin his  
heirs and Assigns for Ever-----  
Further I do positively order that nothing herein contained  
shall be contrary or detrimental to any thing against James  
McFaddin & William McFaddin deed of Gift bearing date 31st  
Jany 1788----- Lastly I constitute and appoint William McFad-  
din Executor of this my last will & testament & I do hereby  
disallow revoke & disannul all former will or Wills or be-  
queaths by the named willed or bequeathed ratifying &
