executors, Nothing Doubting but at the general Resurection,  
I shall Receive the same again by the Mighty power of God, and  
as touching such Worldly goods when with it has pleased God to  
Blesse me with in this life, after having all my Just and  
lawful debts paid, I give bequeath, and dispose of the same in  
the following Manner and form,----

Imprimis, I give and Bequeath unto Ferriby my loving wife one  
bead and furniture and six puter plates and two Cows and Claves  
Item, it is my will and Desire that the rest of my Estate be  
Equilly Divided Between Margt Lifrage, Nancy Hinson, and  
Levinah Bradshaw, and Sarah Barrineu and Margt Barineu to them  
and the heare of their body, Excepting one Shilling Sterling to  
be paid in Money unto my three Sons Jefse Barrineu, Isaac  
Barrineu, & Mandewell Barrineu,----Item, I give and Bequeath  
unto George Downing one three year old Heffer, Item, also one  
Cow and Calf and one two year old Stear I give unto Mikajah  
Downing----

I likewise make Constitute and appoint William Lifrage Executor  
and Arthur Barrineu Executor, and do hereby Revoke and Utterly  
Disannul all former Wills and Testaments before this time made,  
Ratifying and Confirming this and no other to by my last will  
and Testament.
