as soon as convenient for my Executors which will be
named afterwards; 2nd I give devise and bequeath unto my
beloved son John Zuill my Real & Personal Estate in the
Parish of Balfrier in Scotland, North Britain, together with
my Writing Desk, Shot Gun, Silver Goblet; Gold Sleeve Buttons,
Gold headed Cane, Watch & Gold seal Violin & Case, Pistols & two
holsters and my Library of Books----- 3rd I give and bequeath
unto my beloved Wife Margaret Zuill My Bay Horse Chair and
Harnes^s 4th I give devise and bequeath unto my friend Thomas
McConnell Sen my Bulky and one good Bed Bed stead and furni-
ture. 5th I give devise and bequeath unto my beloved wife
Margaret Zuill and my two little children John Zuill and
Jane Presley Zuill, All my Real estate in America with the
residue and remainder of my Personal Estate, ready money,
good chattles, Estate & effects of what nature or kind soever
which I may be possessed of entitled to or interested in at
the time of my decease, to be divided Share and Share alike
between them, Subject however to payment of all my just debts.
Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my beloved Wife
Margaret Zuill Executrix and my friend Thomas McConnell Executor
of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking & making
Void all and every other Will and Wills at any time heretofore
by me made and do declare this to be my last Will & testament.
