JANNET PATTERSON

In the name of God Amen. I. Jannet Patterson being weak of body but of perfect mind and memory--- I recommend my soul unto unto God who gave it and I believe in glorious resurrection of Jesus Christ, and as it pleased God to bless me with such worldly affairs as I possess I dispose of it in the following manner and first I desire and request that my body shall be buried in a Christian like manner at the discretion of my Executors after named 2^d, I request that all my just and lawful debts to be paid, Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Jean Murphy one negro woman called Patt to her and her heirs forever, Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Jannet Wigner two negroes (Viz) named Sharper and Eliza to her and her heirs forever, Item I give unto my Grandson Robert Patterson Greene one negro boy called Bob to him and his heirs forever, Item I give unto my Grand daughter Jannet Hamilton Patterson one negro boy called Fortune to her and her heirs forever Item I give and bequeath unto my Grandson Robert P Wigner one negro boy called Lavender to him and his heirs forever Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Jannet Wigner one sorrel mare called Molly to her and her heirs forever Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Jean Murphy-Jannet Wigner, and my Grand son Robert Patterson Greene, and to my Grand Children Jannet Hamilton Patterson and Robert James Patterson all my lands to be equally divided amongst them----- Item I give and bequeath unto my two grand daughters, Mary M. Flagler and Margaret Patterson one Dollar each-----Item I give and bequeath unto my daughter Jannet Wigner two cows and calves to her and her heirs forever, I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Jannet Wigner one Dutch oven to her and her

Item I give and bequeath unto my two grand daughters, Mary
M. Flagler and Margaret Patterson one Dollar each-----Item
I give and bequeath unto my daughter Jannet Wizner two cows
and calves to her and her heirs forever, I give and bequeath
unto my Daughter Jannet Wizner one Dutch oven to her and her
heirs forever, and I give unto my daughter Jannet Wizner one

Jean Murphy my Mahogany table to her forever, I give unto my
daughter Jannet Wizner one small table to her forever-----
and likewise one Beaufat to the said Jannet Wizner--- my beau-

net Wizner, What money I have left after my death : I request

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to be equally divided between my two Daughters (and the follow
ing Grand Children) Robert Patterson Greene Jannet Hamilton
Patterson, and Robert James Patterson----- I give and be-
queath unto my daughter Jannet Wisner all my chairs---I give
and bequeath unto my Grand son Robert F Greene one Cow and
calf to him and his hirs forever, I revoke and disannul all
other wills and testaments untill this day, I give unto son
in law Robt Greene three sheets--- I own this to be my last
will and testament to this day; Given under my hand and seal
this 18th day of September 1818.---

and in the forty first of the Independence of the United
States of America--- I leave and ap point Andrew Patterson
and James McFaddin my lawful Executors-----
