District, State South Carolina-----I James Campbell considering  
the uncertainty of this Mortal Life, and being of sound mind  
and Memory / BleSsed by Almighty God, for the same / Do make  
and publish this my last Will and testament, in manner and for-  
m following (To Wit) First, I give and bequeath unto Susanna  
Covert, the House and Lands whereon I reside, together with my  
House hold furniture, during her Life time, and at her Death it  
is my Will that the said House and Lands together with what rem-  
ains of the furniture, should revert to, and descend to my Nep-  
hew William Campbell---Item, I give and bequeath to Laura Cov-  
ert, my Negroe Girl Tenah--- Item I give and bequeath unto Sus-  
anna Covert, Isaac Nelson, my Nephew William Campbell, my sis-  
ters AgneSs Brown, Elizabeth Todd, and Mary Campbell, the rest  
residue and remainder of my personal Estate, goods, Chattles  
of what kind and nature soever, to be equally divided among  
them----Item, and lastly, it is my Will and desire, that if my  
Nephew William Campbell, should die, before he arrives at the x  
age of twenty one Years, or leave no Issue, that the bequest to  
him of Lands, furniture & personal Property be equally divided  
between, Susanna Covert, Isaac Nelson, AgneSs Brown, Elizabeth  
Todd and Mary Campbell, I do hereby appoint and nominate my fri-  
ends, William Salters, and Isaac Nelson my Executors and Susan-  
na Covert my Executrix of this my last will and testament here-  
by revoking all former Wills by me made---In testameny whereof  
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fourth day of March  
in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred twenty five-  
Signed sealed and declared in the presence of us  
as his last Will and testament
