half of the money to continue on interest till my Son James  
Lafayette Folly arrives to the age of twenty one years old or  
marries then to receive it I also wish my Executors to pro-  
vide a home for my two Children Margaret and James where they  
may think a suitable place and to give the said Margaret One  
years Schooling and James two years Schooling, I also wish my  
house farm plantation goods and Chattles to continue in the care  
of Robert Spring who is living in the house with me till sold  
by my Executors whom I nominate Constitute and appoint Solomon  
Coward and William J. Timmons Sole Executors of this my last  
will and testament hereby revoking all other and former Wills  
by me at any time here to fore made, In witness where of I have  
here unto Set my hand and Seal the twelfth day of June in the  
Year of Our Lord Eighteen hundred and thirty five, Signed Seal-  
ed published and declared by the said testator James Folly to  
be as and for his last Will and testament in the presence of  
us who have Subscribed our names as witnesses there to in pres-  
ence of the said testator
