WILL OF JAMES F. PRESSLEY.

Williamsburgh District So Carolina

october 18t 1834 ----

In the name of God Amen I, James F. Pressley of the district and state aforesaid, being weak in body, but of sound and disposing mind, do hereby make this my last will and testament as follows ---- Viz -- I give, devise and bequeath, to my beloved wife Eliza, the three negroes I received with her, name-ly sarah, and her two children Hannah and Harriet, also my negro man Scipio, and my bay horse & chair. ----

I give, devise, and bequeath to my beloved daughter Mary, three negroes Viz. Tirah, "illiam and Suewith the future issue and increase of the females, during the term of her natural life, and at her death to the lawful issue of her body, togather with the residue of my estate both real and personal.

It is my will that all my just debts be paid before the above legacies are paid off --

I do hereby nominate and appoint my wife Eliza and my brother John B Preseley, executrix and executor of this my last will and testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal in presence of these witnesses
