as will willfully appear by refference to the deed of convey-
ance from me to Edward Whitney for the two hundred acres afores-
aid Item I give and bequeath to my said Daughter Eliza
Trtitchiuhaul all my stock of Cattle the stock marked with a
sharp in one ear and split and upperbit in the other and
Branded S also my stock of Cattle marked with a sharp in one
ear and upperbit in the other and Branded 39. also my stock of
Cattle marked with a sharp in one Ear and underbit in the other
and Branded T H and I do hereby give devise and bequeath unto
my beloved Daughter Eliza Trtitchiuhaul wife of Thomas Hitchin-
ham all the rest residue and remainder of my Estate whatsoever
both real and personal and lastly I do hereby Nominate and Con-
stitute and appoint my well Beloved friend and Daughter Eliza
Trtitchiuhaul my sole " " " " " Executive of this my last
Will and Testament In witness whereof I have the said James
Ward have hereunto set my hand affixed my seal at Williamsburg

the year of our Lord one thousand and Eight hundred and twenty
