

In the name of God Amen I James, of the District and State aforesaid Being of sound & disposing mind and memory and Considering the uncertainty of Life do hereby make this my last Will and Testament Hereby Revoking all and every other will or wills heretofore by me made First I recommend my Soul to God and Will that all my Just debts and funeral Expences be fully paid and Satisfied Item I will devise and bequeath unto my Daughter Eliza Trtitchiuaur wife of Thomas Aitchiuaur all the remainder of that tract piece or parcel of Land formerly containing twelve hundred acres cut of which I sold to Edward Whitley two hundred acres Situated in the District and State aforesaid which Said Tract was Surveyed for James Ward on the eighth day of June one thousand seven hundred and Eighty nine as will willfully appear by reference to the deed of conveyance from me to Edward Whitley for the two hundred acres aforesaid Item I give and bequeath to my said Daughter Eliza Trtitchiuaur all my stock of Cattle the stock marked with a sharp in one ear and split and upperbit in the other and Branded S also my stock of Cattle marked with a sharp in one Ear and ~~upperbit~~ in the other and Branded 39. also my stock of Cattle marked with a sharp in one Ear and underbit in the other and Branded T H and I do hereby give devise and bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Eliza Trtitchiuaur wife of Thomas Hitchinham all the rest residue and remainder of my Estate whatsoever both real and personal and lastly I do hereby Nominate and Constitute and appoint my well Beloved friend and Daughter Eliza Trtitchiuaur my sole " " " " " " Executive of this my last Will and Testament In witness whereof I ~~have~~ the Said James Ward have hereunto set my hand affixed my seal at Williamsburg In the State of South Carolina This Tenth--day of March--- in the year of our Lord one thousand and Eight hundred and twenty nine and in the fifty ^{third} year of the Independence of the
