Octf 4th. 1818. being verry sick, and not having an oppertun-
ity to make a regular Will, This is to be considred as my Will
----- I give and bequeath John Gaillard Keith Gourdin my Negro
boy Captain and all my personal effects consisting of Notes
and amounts against Theodore Gourdin amounting to Two Thousand
Five hundred and thirteen dollars, Ninety nine cents, also a
note on John Doby for Five hundred and five dollars and Thirty
cents Together with my wearing appearel as witness my hand and
seal the year and day above mention-----
