I John Scott Sen<sup>r</sup> State South Carolina, Williamsburgh District, being of sound mind, & Memory do make & Publish this my last Will & testament, in manner following. I give and bequeath unto my son Joseph all that plantation or tract of land which he now plants bought of John Chambers, Also one Negroe man Named Jack & one Negroe Woman Named Labioy, (his Wife) & there two children Nancy Lizzy with there future encrease to him & his heirs forever. As his full part or Share of my real & personal Estate.

Should my wife Rebecca have a living Child by marriage with me it is my will & desire that it shall heir half as much as one childs part. to be taken out of my real & personal Estate which I possessed at my marriage with said Rebecca. except that part above mentioned to my son Joseph.

Also it is my will & desire that said child shall receive a Certain part of the real and personal estate which I got by marriage with said Rebecca as will make its part or Share equal with my five Children (Viz). Sarah Margret, John Thomas, William Robert, Albert Alexander McCrea, Samuel James Washington, the part given my son Joseph still excepted---to the better understanding of which it will appear that it is my intention to make this childs part or Share equal with my five Children above mentioned.--but in case that this unborn child should die before it arives to the age of twenty one years or marriage the part I will<sup>d</sup>, out of my former estate shall return to my five Children above mentioned or there decendants & the part I will<sup>d</sup> to it of the estate I got by marriage with said Rebec-

Item I give & bequ unto my Wife Rebecca all the remainder of ~~the~~ the ~~marriage~~ estate I got by marriage with her to be deposs<sup>d</sup>, of here after as she may think proper also my four wheel Riding Carriage.---Also I give & bequeath unto my Wife Rebecca my Celeret & large Mahogany dining table to her during her natural life & at her death to return to my Younger children or their decendants, my son Joseph excepted.--It is farther my

wish & desire that my five Younger children above Named shall live on the plantation where my Wife Rebecca now resides, as also my grey Horse Larry, one negroe man Sam & wench Polly as long as it may be found to be agreeable by my executors for them to remain there, but should the children be removed the last mentioned property is to remove with them. I give & bequeath unto my Daughter Sarah Margaret one new bed & furniture to be made as soon as possible.----

I give & bequeath unto my Son John Thomas one bed & furniture.--

I give & bequeath unto my Son William Robert one bed & furniture. Also one hundred dollars for his education.----

I give & bequeath unto my son Albert Alexander McCrea one bed & furniture also two hundred dollars for his education.---

I give & bequeath unto my son Samuel James Washington one bed & furniture also two hundred dollars for his education.--

It is my will & desire that after all my Just debts are paid, that the whole of the rest residue & remainder of my estate both real & personal shall be equally divided amongst my five younger children (Viz) Sarah Margaret.--John Thomas.--William Robert.--Albert Alexander McCrea.--Samuel James Washington.--

Share and Share alike.

lastly I constitute, Nominate & appoint my Wife Rebecca Executrix together with my Brother Joseph Scott Executor and my son John Thomas Executor as soon as he comes to the age of Twenty one years of this my last will & testament in witness of all and each of the things herein contained I have set my han & Seal this 29<sup>th</sup> of Aprill in the year of our Lord 1820.--
