for the sam, Calling to Mind the Mortality of my Body and
Knowing that it is appointed for all once to die, do Make and
Ordain this my last Will and Testament, in Manner and form
following---Imprimus first and principally I Recommend my Soul
into the hands of Almighty God, who gave it, and my Body to the
Earth, to be Buried in a decent and Christian like Manner
Nothing Doubting but at the General Resurrection, I shall Rece-
ive the same again, by the Almighty God, And as Touching such
Worldly Wstate as it has pleased God to bless me With in this
life, I give and devise bequeath and dispose of in the follow-
ing Manner.

Item. I will and Bequeath all my Real Estate I die
possessed of to be Equally divided Between my Beloved Wife
Susanna Connor, and my two Daughters, Ann Mary, Ray Connor and
Sarah Margaret Connor Unless the Child my Wife is now pregnant
With, should be a Male Child in that Case, I will and Bequeath
all my Real Estate to that Child, and in Case the Child should
be a female Its my Will and desire that it has an Equal share
with its Mother and my two before Named Daughters

Item I will and Bequeath all my Personal Estate of
Every description to be Equally divided, Between my Beloved
Wife Susanna Connors and my two Daughters Ann Mary Ray Connor,
and Sarah Margaret Connor, and the Child my Wife is at the time
