I John McNicholl Connor, of Williamsburgh District being Very Weak and low of Body, but of sound and disposing Mind and Memory, thanks be given to Almighty God for the same, Calling to Mind the Mortality of my Body and Knowing that it is appointed for all once to die, do Make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament, in Manner and form following---Imprimis first and principally I Recommend my Soul into the hands of Almighty God, who gave it, and my Body to the Earth, to be Buried in a decent and Christian like Manner Nothing Doubting but at the General Resurrection, I shall Receive the same again, by the Almighty God, And as Touching such Worldly Estate as it has pleased God to bless me With in this life, I give and devise bequeath and dispose of in the following Manner.

Item I will and Bequeath all my Real Estate I die possessed of to be Equally divided Between my Beloved Wife Susanna Connor, and my two Daughters, Ann Mary, Ray Connor and Sarah Margaret Connor Unless the Child my Wife is now pregnant with, should be a Male Child in that Case, I will and Bequeath all my Real Estate to that Child, and in Case the Child should be a female Its my Will and desire that it has an Equal share with its Mother and my two before Named Daughters

Item I will and Bequeath all my Personal Estate of Every description to be Equally divided, Between my Beloved Wife Susanna Connor and my two Daughters Ann Mary, Ray Connor, and Sarah Margaret Connor, and the Child my Wife is at the time pregnant With Its my Will and Desire should have an Equal part
