Keels Richard T Keels and Robert F Keels I give and devise the whole of my real Estate to be equally divided among them share and share alike to them their heirs and Afsigna forever Item --- To my only daughter Mary Maria Keels I give and bequeaththe choice of a negro girl to be selected by her from among the residue of my negroes not herein already bequeathed to her and her heire foreve; Item---All the rest and residue of my persoanl Estate I give and bequeath to my said children to be equally distributed among them Share-and Share-alike without-any other or further discrimination to them and their heirs forever---Item--- It is however my will and desire that should any of my said children die leaving no children that then and in that case the share or portion which they may have received of my said Estate by virtue of this my last will and testament shall go to and be equally divided smong my said Children surviving----- And I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my said two sons Peter-R Keels and James W Keels executors of this my last will and testament hereby, revoking and making void all and every other. will or wills at any time heretofore by me made and do declars this to be my last will and testament ---- In witness whereof I the said John Keels have herewith set my hand and seal this
