I will and bequeath unto my Step Mother Sarah M Lowry and my half Sister Ann S Lowry a Legacy of one Thousand Dollars left me by my uncle Samuel Lowry also Three Hundred Dollars being part of a Legacy of Six hundred Dollars left me by my uncle Robert Lowry also all my other property both real and personal to be equally divided share and share alike. And I do hereby Constitute and appoint Samuel Scott and John Scott my Executors of this my last will and Testament. ---

Witness my hand and Seal ^{this} 14th day of September in the year of our Lord One Thousand eight hundred and Twenty Six and in the Fifty ~~fourth~~ first year of Americas Independence. ---
