JOHN MONTGOMERY

The State of South Carolina.

In the Name of God Amen. I John Montgomery, of Williamsburg District, being weak in body, but of Sound mind, Memory, and Understanding, Praised be God for the same do make this my last will, and Testament, in Manner and Form Following. (VIZ) First, I bequeath Unto My Beloved Mother, Jane Montgomery my Negro Girl Alvira, and Mare Roda. Second, I will and bequeath, Unto my beloved Brother Isaac--- Montgomery, all my ready Money, and all moneys, due me, for the Purpose, of Paying off, all my Just debts, and I likewise bequeath to him my negro man Paul, Loom and Gear, half of my Stock of Hogs, and my Black Horse Negro.

Third I will and bequeath to my beloved Brother William Montgomery my Negro Man Sharper, and my Plows & Gear, my Watch, Great Coat, and half my Stock of Hogs, and my Trunk.

Fourth. I Will and bequeath Two Hundred Dollars, to be equally Divided Between my Beloved Sister, Rachel McCauley, and her Two Daughters Amarintha N. & Mary Jane Plowden, one Hundred and fifty Dollars to be paid by James Montgomery, and Fifty by Samuel S Montgomery.

Fifth I will and bequeath to my beloved Sister Jane Plowden my negro Girl Lucy.

Sixth I will and bequeath to my beloved Brother James Montgomery Half of my land, Dividing it as it has ^{ALL} been Divided, from North, to South with the Mill & all Belonging Thereto, By paying to my sister Rachel and her Two Daughters one Hundred and fifty Dollars.

Seventh, I will and bequeath to my beloved Brother Samuel I.

fifty Dollars to be paid by James Montgomery, and Fifty by Sam-
uel S Montgomery

Fifth I will and bequeath to my beloved Sister Jane Plowden my
negro Girl Lucy.

Sixth I will and bequeath to my beloved Brother James Mont-
gomery Half of my land, Dividing it as it has ^{ALL} been Divided, from
North, to South with the Mill & all Belonging Thereto, By pay-
ing to my sister Rachel and her Two Daughters one Hundred and
fifty Dollars.

Seventh, I will and bequeath to my beloved Brother Samuel I.
Montgomery the Western Half of my land adjoining his land, and
to pay to my Sister Rachel, and her Two Daughters, Amarintha
N. & Mary Jane Plowden, Fifty Dollars.

Eighth, I will and bequeath to my beloved Brother Henry Mont-
gomery my Horse Farmer.

Nineth. I will and bequeath to my beloved Sister Leatita Mont-
gomery my Crop of Cotton

Tenth. I will and bequeath that all the reaminder of my Prop-
erty not Herin mentioned, Corn, Cattle, Sheep, &c, be Equally
