

JOHN PERDRIAU

In the name of God Amen, I John Perdriau of Williamsburgh District and State of South Carolina Planter being of sound mind and memory, but of feable health, do make publish and declare this my last will and testament in manner and form following:-

Item first- I give and bequeath to my beloved Wife, Ann Perdriau, all my Household and Kitchen furniture, stock of Horses Cattle, sheep, and Hogs, and the following named Negroes, To Wit--- Phoebe Melia, William, John, Mary, Henry, Leah, Hercules, Taffee Sharlow, and Carolina, to will and dispose of as she may think proper.

Item Second- I give to Henry Lemid my plantation on which he now resides containing about Nine Hundred and Nine Acres, more or less, situated in Williamsburgh District, and butting and bounding, as follows, North on lands of the Estate of Oliver Cromwell, East on lands of Isaac Singletary, South on lands unknown, West on lands of Samuel Bennett--- I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my wife Ann Perdriau, Executrix to this my last will and testament--- I n witness whereof I have set my Hand and seal this forth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight Hundred and forty two---
