

In the name of God Amen I John Rogers of the State and
District aforesaid being sound in Mind and memory call-
ing to mind the mortality of my Body and that it is ap-
pointed to me once to Die and after that to judgement
Do ordain make and constitute this my last will and
Testament in Manner and form following viz,

First I give and bequeath to my Daughter Letha Sauks
one hundred and eighteen and half Acre of land Orig-
inally granted to John Mc Alister including the house
and plantation whereon she now lives to her and the law-
ful issue of her Body forever

2nd I give all the Rest of my lands to be Equally
Divided between William Rogers Shadrack Rest Rogers
Susannah Rogers Martha Jane Rogers with the Exception
of the house and plantation whereon I now live that
to remain with my beloved wife Margrata Rogers During
her Natural life then to be divided as aforesaid between
the four last mentioned children and the part that falls
to Susannah and Martha Jane to remain with them and the
law issue of their Body for Ever and if Either of the
mentioned Children should Desease with out leaveing any
lawful issue there part to be Equally Divided between the
afore mentioned surviving part

3rd I will that all my stock household and kitchen furni-
ture be left with my wife, viz. Margaret Rogers During
her life time and then to be Equally Divided between the
four last mentioned children all to be managed and Divided
by my Two sons John F Rogers and William Rogers Whom I
Ordain and appoint sole Executors to my last will and Testament
Signed sealed and Declared and published to be my last will
and testament Revoking all other wills or Testaments by
me heretofore this ninth Day of October in the year of our
Lord one Thousand Eight hundred and ThirtyTwo and in the
