Singletary annually Interest of four hundred Dollars for her support as it is my wish that she receive only the Interest till she arrives at full age marries at which time my Executors shall pay shall the such sum of four hundred Dollars together with the unexpended Interest that may remain due thereon and in case the said Sophronea P. Singleton should die Leving no ISSue of her body then the said four hundred Dollars and unexpended Interest aforesaid shall be Equally Divided between mother now Sarah Singleton alive or her ISSue if dead and my Daughter Martha Dickey to them and their heirs for Ever
