Rogers, I give and devise the following named negroes: Lizette, Susannah, Pat, George, Jim and Tenah, with the future issue and increase of the females thereof, to her, for and during the term of her natural life, and at her death, to such of her children as may survive her, and such of her Grand Children whose parent or parents may be dead---to be equally divided among them -- the Grand children taking the share or shares to which their deceased parent or parents would be entitled. It is my particular desire that the property herein bequeathed to my said Daughter shall not, in any event, nor under any circumstances, be considered liable for the debts of her present Husband, nor for the debts of any future Husband she may marry I do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint my friend the said Benjamin King.
