In the ^Name of God amen--I Joseph Ervin in the district of
Williamsburgh and State of South Carolina being weak in body
but of sound mind and memory do make and appoint this my last
will and Testament revoking and annulling all other ^Wills
and Testaments heretofore made by me--Imprimis it is my wish
that my body be decently buried and that all my Just and law-
ful debts be paid--Item I give and bequeath unto John Gaillard
Keith Gourdin my two men servants Dick and Captain together
with my wearing apparel, and all accounts and Notes due to me
any [|]every persons whatsoever--and I do hereby appoint Doctr.
Thomas Day Singleton my Executor to this my last will and
Testament, in Testimony whereof I hereunto set my hand and seal
this 6th. October 1816. in the presence of
